Rules: Current NRA Pistol Rules will govern this match although this is not an NRA approved

match.

**Eligibility:** Entries are open to a maximum of 18 competitors.

Entry Fees: Three guns - \$20; Two guns - \$15; One gun - \$10. Fees may be paid with check or

cash.

**Entries Close:** At the time of competition.

**Classification:** NRA classifications will be used. In the event two or less Masters and High Masters compete, they will only be eligible for the open awards. Three or more competitors are required to make a class, otherwise they will compete in the next higher class. An unclassified shooter will compete in the Master class. If there are two or more unclassified shooters, they will form an Unclassified class and they will compete for awards in that class as well as open awards.

.22 Caliber Only Matches: Competitors may shoot a .22 caliber pistol for the Center-Fire and .45 caliber matches as permitted by Section 22 of the NRA rules. They will compete for awards in the .22 caliber matches (matches 1, 2, 3 & 4) with other shooters. For the Center-Fire and .45 Caliber matches they will not be eligible for awards unless there are at least two such shooters in which case they will compete between only themselves for awards.

**Relay Times:** Firing will start promptly at 6:30 pm for the first (Friday) relay. The second relay will begin at 8:30 am on Saturday. The entire match will be fired in one relay; competitors may choose to fire in either the Friday relay or the Saturday relay – not both.

Entries are limited to 9 persons per relay.

**Challenges:** A fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. Challenges may be made up to one hour after the scores to be challenged are posted.

**Awards:** 75% of the entry fees will be returned as awards. Awards will be given for open winners and for each class winner. Second place awards will be given in classes with five or more competitors and third place awards will be given in classes with nine or more competitors. Awards will be in the form of cash.

**General Info:** Everyone on the range must use eye and ear protection while firing is in progress. The facility is a 25 yard indoor range with turning targets. There is a clubroom with bathrooms for men and women and water, sodas and snacks are available for purchase. A convenience store and motel are nearby.
